Transportation: On your own (car pooling encouraged)

Arrival: 7:00 pm Friday (Webelos after 1:30 pm on Saturday)**Departure:** 10 am Sunday

Facilities: This is an indoor facility with normal household amenities. Depending on the turnout for this event, some older scouts may need to sleep outside or in the big room. We will make sure everyone has suitable sleeping arrangements. We will advise you after we know the signup size. We do need to provide drinking water so bring your own **Filled canteen** to help minimize the amount of drinking water we must bring.

Saturday Morning- Leadership Seminar Preparation (Senior Scouts) Younger Scout activities TBD (older scouts may use this time to prepare for afternoon activities)

Saturday Lunch- Troop provided

Saturday Afternoon- We will offer First year advancement opportunities, Games and activities for other scouts and the Webelos. We will also offer an Introduction to Boy Scouts session for Webelos and their Parents.

Saturday Dinner- Each patrol will do their own Dutch oven meal. Troop will provide salad And we will do dutch oven desserts.

Saturday Evening- Skits and Stories followed by a Movie.

Sunday Breakfast Troop Provided

Sunday Morning- Cleanup and church service.

Meals: All meals except for Saturday's Main Dish will be done by the Troop. Meals will include Crackerbarrel both evenings. **Dinner on Friday night should be at home.**

Equipment: All standard outing equipment including uniform, handbook and cold weather gear. The bunks need a mat –they no longer have mattresses.

Cost: Boy Scouts and Adults \$25- covers all food and lodge fee. Webelos & their Parents cost- \$10(for food)

Directions: Route 1 to Route 41 South. Go through the light past the Wawa and into town to the second light (there is a Sunoco on the left) Make a right at this light and go about 50 yards to Pomeroy Ave. It is about 10 feet before you get to RR tracks. Make a right on Pomeroy- it is a narrow road and will soon turn into a gravel road. Follow it for about half a mile. It will cross a bridge and then when you cross the RR tracks the building ahead of you is the cabin.

Need to Come Late or Leave Early? One of the advantages of this weekend is that most people can make it even if they have other activities due to the proximity to home. Please let us know at signup if you will be arriving late or leaving early or for part of the weekend so we can plan for food accordingly.
