



Horseshoe December Outing

Transportation: By personal car or truck. If you can carry at least 5 total passengers and your scout is attending, please consider volunteering for this outing. You are welcome to join us for the weekend. If necessary we will ask some people to drive down even if not staying.

Amenities: Running water, mattresses, heat by cast iron stove. Outside bathroom facilities.

Cost: \$30 for all participants. Covers food, camping and auto expenses. \$20 for webelos and their parents.

Meals: Breakfasts and lunch will be served as a troop. Dinner will be done by patrol: Dutch oven cooking.

Program: We will have a mountain bike course to ride. Scouts must wear required safety equipment. We also will have an orientation program and a hike. Family Life Merit badge will be offered. We may also have an additional merit badge-TBD.

Signups: We will start taking signups on November 21. At minimum, we would like to know your intention to attend. We also must know if you plan to bring a bike.

November 28 we will collect the remainder of any money and forms. Participants will discuss meals and skits.
