Date and Time; The dates are Friday, September 16th, leaving the Pennsbury Township building at 5:45 . We realize this will be early for some of you, but it is necessary; **please arrive at the township parking lot for assembly at 5:30.**

We will be returning between 12:00, and 2:00, on Sunday the 18th. We will use our cell phone chain, to contact parents, when we're about a half hour away from Pennsbury, for pick up.

Sign up date; the last available sign up date will be September 12th. We will be assigning patrols during the Troop meeting, and doing menu selections.

Transportation; We will be looking for adult drivers. If you are driving we ask that you please be willing to take other scouts with you. Drivers will be reimbursed for fuel only if there is a minimum of four total people in their vehicle.

For this particular trip, since we're taking the Troop Trailer, and canoe trailers, vehicles that have a class two hitch are extremely desirable.

Scout dress code; Troop 31 always travels in class A, please bring your other Scouting T shirts for the rest of the weekend.

Activities; We will be offering the Fishing Merit Badge, and the Reptile-Amphibian Merit Badge. Some canoes, and Kayaks will also be taken down for fun, and if anyone needs to work on the Canoeing Merit Badge.

** Please feel free to bring any fishing equipment you want for the lake, but please, no hooks already set up on lines, danger Will Robinson !

Adults, who want to fish in the lake, will need a temporary Adult Delaware fishing license. This is available on line,

It's referred to as a 7 day tourist license.

Sleeping Accommodations; all attendees will be in Troop tents.

Water/Restroom Availability; running potable water is available at the campsite, toilets will be available.

Dinner will not be provided for Friday night, but there will be a cracker barrel later in the evening after set up. Please have your scout eat before departure.
